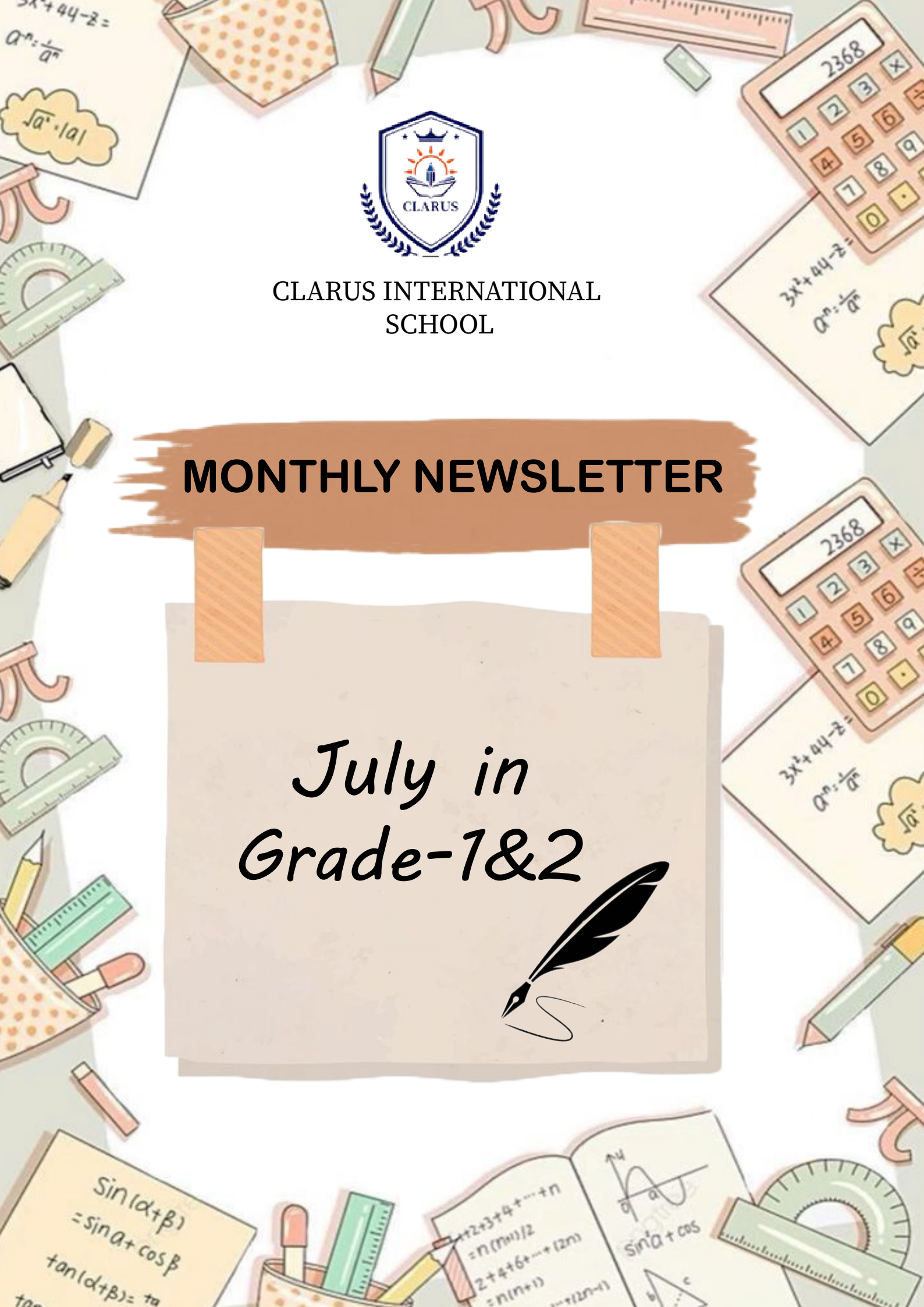

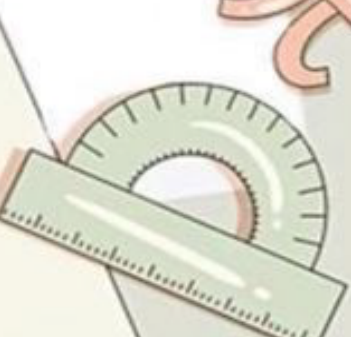

"With this project, we are bringing a playful and inclusive approach to learning Braille. I hope children, parents, caregivers, teachers and practitioners worldwide will be as excited as we are." said John Goodwin, CEO of the Lego Foundation.

The bricks, will be compatible with Lego's wider collection, this means that friends and family members can play along.
